There are roughly 189,000 ER visits by persons under age 21 for injuries linked to alcohol per year.

Teens who start drinking alcohol before age 25 are 6 times more likely to develop alcohol dependence later in life.

Approximately 700,000 students are assaulted by other students who have been drinking alcohol each year.
